Objectives

BioBoost-Pro tackles the barriers for the uptake of **bioponics** by all value chain stakeholders by: **implementing and demonstrating** bioponics in real life through 11 pilots; enabling the **replication** with **transnational tool** development; and raising awareness and capacity building. By this, BioBoost-Pro aims to reinforce the value chain stakeholders from hydroponic sector to make the **transition from a linear** (petrochemical fertilizers) **to a circular value chain**, thus decreasing manure pollution and preventing loss of valuable nutrients.
